The second amendment proposed was a dues increase to the District, but it was withdrawn before it could be voted on. Another matter on the floor was to endorse PG Eric Paul, who was running for International Trustee. It was decided that Past Governor Eric would wait until the 2026 International Convention, which will be held in Manilla, Philippines, to run for International Trustee, so the matter was withdrawn as well.

It was another great event, organized and run by Convention Chairs DPLG Kerrie and DPP Steve Hansen, and we encourage everyone to attend next year's convention.
