



Each year, the observation of *Veterans Day* is an important date on our calendar. We had a good group of members and guests in attendance for our annual meeting. Pres Anna opened the meeting in the usual manner, calling on Karen Kramer for an Invocation, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and 'My Country 'Tis of Thee'. Pres Anna scored 100% on the introductions of our Past Leadership. She's making it look easy.

Each year, we remember the sacrifices made by all the men and women that served

in the military, celebrating their patriotism and willingness to serve our nation and protect our freedom. Our **Veterans Day** 

program was presented by Jon Kablack. He began with his story.

He joined the Coast Guard in 1989 after a visit before a judge who offered him community service. After boot camp in Cape May, NJ, he was stationed for a time on a rescue ship on Governors Island. Afterwards, he was assigned to Guantánamo Bay, dealing with a surge of Haitian immigrants. During that time, he responded to a



capsized ferry, where 1100 of the 1200 passengers perished. Subsequently, he was assigned to Ft Wadsworth in NJ, working on the Drug Task Force. Unfortunately, in 2000, he was thrown from a boat while on patrol and suffered a broken back, which has required four surgeries (so far). Regardless, he is proud of his service time. He continued the program by reading a tribute of gratitude to all servicemen and women.



Following Jon, we had additional information from our 'Plan B'. Richie Adams had prepared some remarks in case Jon was unable to attend the meeting, and he shared the tradition of wearing red to honor and support veteran causes. The acronym R.E.D. stands for 'Remember Everyone Deployed'.

We closed the program with members raising Happy \$\$ and remembering their loved ones who served. It is always a meaningful time to reflect on service, sacrifice and the commitment to peace.

**REMINDER:** on Tuesday, November 11 at 11:00am, we will be gathering at the Glendale War Monument with local veteran posts to observe *Veterans Day*, with a ceremony conducted by Bill Cook and the American Legion 104 Post, who are also members of our club.

Before the program, we received an addendum on last week's *Halloween Parade*. Apparently, Friday night was rather windy. I mean *Real Windy! Very Windy!!* Everyone who raised Happy \$\$ for the event made a point of the wind, which had the goodie bags blowing off the tables. Regardless, everyone in attendance said the event was a success. JR Velepec thanked Karen Kramer, DPP Ingrid Huber and DPLG Kerrie Hansen for all the help with setup and costume judging. Also, he thanked Rudy Jonke and Lucien Matej for their help transporting the stage to and from Maspeth Federal Savings.
