This week's program was a report from our friends at the **104th Precinct Community Council**. Pres Anna rang the bell to start the proceedings, and Karen Kramer delivered an Invocation for safety for all policemen and women. After the Pledge and Patriotic Song, Anna walked around the room and only had three Past Leaders to introduce. Easy day.

Originally established in the 1940's, Precinct Community Councils are forums that provide on-going, direct communication between the police and community. Besides holding monthly meetings around the precinct to discuss quality of life issues, they spend countless hours educating the community about crime prevention and public safety. They are a constant presence at local events, such as parades, street fairs, movie nights in the park, and the annual *National Night Out*.

Today, their current President, Jon Kablack was joined by Police Officers Dilsia Bonilla and Mike Gonzalez. Big Jon started with a personal note. He thanked everyone for their thoughts and prayers for his mother, who recently passed away. Then, he turned the program over to PO Dilsia and PO Mike, two crime prevention officers who reported on recent trends and occurrences in the neighborhood. They noted that burglaries were on the rise, and bank fraud and utility robberies were still a serious concern. Also, AI fraud cases are difficult to solve. They reminded everyone to be aware of unsolicited mail, emails and phone calls from unknown sources, and to contact law enforcement at the first sign of trouble.

It is always a pleasure to have the Community Council join us, and they welcome everyone to attend their monthly meetings to stay informed.

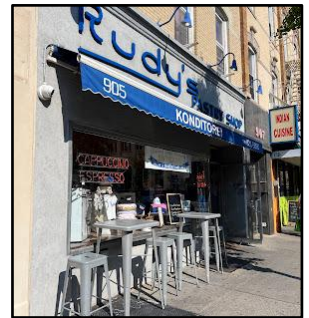
